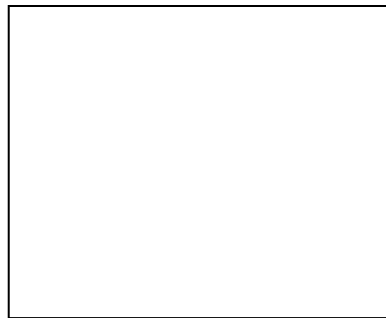
1. Kings are allowed to wear crowns in church. Who are the two kings at the west end?

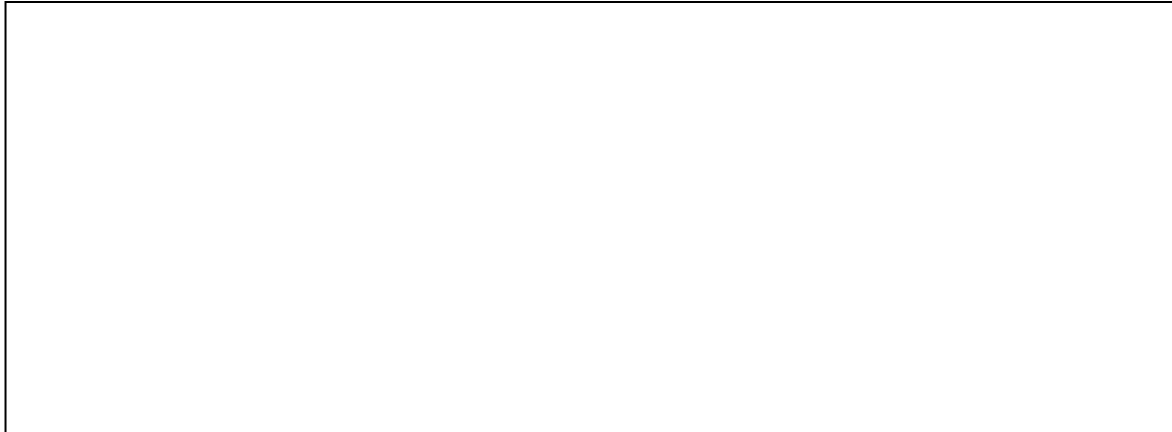
9. What would you expect a diver to be wearing on his head?
